Here’s what people can expect at the event:

- Everyone will be handed a bag of materials upon driving up, including masks and sanitizers
- Cars will be parked with a single space in between
- It is recommended that you bring your own lawn chair if you’d like to sit outside your car
- No food or drinks will be provided but you are encouraged to bring your own
- No public restrooms will be open as they provide a create risk to the public

“We know that people with social connection live 20% longer. We are seeing that the lack of social connection has a real impact on quality of life. We want people to at least be able to have eye contact in person, not through Zoom,” says Jones.
